Jamia Siraj ul Uloom recognises that your privacy is very important, and we take it seriously. When you use our services you trust us with your information, and we're committed to upholding that trust to the highest standards.

This privacy policy describes our policies and procedures about the collection, use, disclosure, and sharing of your personal information or personal data when you use Jamia Siraj ul Uloom's services.

The Information We Collect

We collect information only from our service users directly. This may include, depending on the service you use:

- Name
- Contact details. (E-mail address, address, contact number).
- Gender/Age range
- General communication. When you communicate with us (via email, phone or otherwise), we may maintain a record of your communication.

Purposes for Using Your Information

We do not sell or rent your information to any third parties under any circumstances, unless you have explicitly asked us to do so.

- Providing our Services. To provide the services we offer (eg, attending a course) , to communicate with you about your use of our services, respond to your queries or any other customer service purpose.
- Marketing. To send you information about news from Jamia Siraj ul Uloom, courses, events, other services that we may feel to be beneficial to you or those you know.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your browser or device by websites, apps, online media, and advertisements. There are different types of cookies. Cookies served by the entity that operates the domain you are visiting are called "first party cookies." So cookies served by Jamia Siraj ul Uloom while you are on www.jamia.co.uk are first party cookies. Cookies served by companies that are not operating the domain you're visiting are called "third party cookies." So, we may allow Google to set a cookie on your browser while you visit www.jamia.co.uk, and that would be a third party cookie. Cookies may also endure for different periods of time. "Session Cookies" only last only as long as your browser is open. These are deleted automatically once you close your browser.

Jamia Siraj Ul Uloom uses cookies to store anonymous and unidentifiable information when someone visits our website. We do this to understand how our users use our website and to provide better user experience. If you wish to control the use of our website cookies, you may change your browsers settings.

How we protect your information

When you attend any of our events or courses or use any of our services, you trust us with your data. Our data handlers and staff uphold this trust and have implemented safeguards to ensure your data is protected on our side from fraud, malicious threats and unauthorised access.

However, no website or Internet transmission is completely secure. We urge you to take steps to keep your personal information safe, such as using a secured device with virus protection software.
