We would like to once again thank you for your support and duas during the ongoing Coronavirus crisis.


We are writing to you to explain the Jamia's arrangements for remote/online lessons. We have carried out risk assessments, trained our staff, re-arranged timings and reviewed and produced policies - among other actions – in order to be as well prepared as possible to deliver remote/online lessons.

Grouping Arrangements and Curriculum

For logistical reasons, pupils in Junior Maktab (JM) and Boys' Maktab (BM) will be placed into small groups of 4 students (hence Junior Maktab and Boys' Maktab classes will be divided into four groups each). Each group will have their own dedicated teacher (Ustadh). After completing their lesson with their respective teacher, JM and BM pupils will log-in to a whole class learning session supervised by another teacher.

The Girls' Maktab (GM) will be divided into 2 groups, taught by the same teacher at varying times.

We will communicate individually with parents about which group your child is in.








LOGIN TO YOUR LESSON

Once you have logged in to Zoom, the following window will appear:



HOW TO UNMUTE YOUR AUDIO

If teacher cannot hear your child, perhaps the microphone needs to be enabled.

If your child cannot hear the teacher, perhaps the volume on the device needs to be turned up.



Expectations of Pupils/Parents

Assuming they are well enough to work, students are expected to:

- Complete all work set for them and submitting work which is requested for feedback promptly
- Check emails regularly and read and respond to communication from the Jamia
- Where students experience problems with IT systems or any other matter that may affect their ability to participate in distance learning, they/parents should proactively contact the Jamia at info@jamia.co.uk
- Students/parents are expected to uphold the same standards of conduct and behaviour during live online lessons as they would be expected to in Jamia. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Ensuring appropriate language is used in online comments or emails, and that any comment is on-topic and relevant to the task in hand.
 - Ensuring full engagement with the tasks in hand, including submission of any required work by the deadline that has been set.
 - Ensuring that clothing is appropriate, following the uniform policy.

Parents should:

- Stay within viewing and listening distance of their child to ensure their child is engaged according to timetable and is safe online.
- Ensure their child is in attendance and punctual online
- Inform the Jamia of absence on info@jamia.co.uk
- Make sure their child has access to a desktop computer, laptop or a tablet.
- Make sure their child has somewhere they can work at home and allow for 2 hours of study each day.
- Report any safeguarding or other concerns whether online or in general to the Jamia's Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) via email at info@jamia.co.uk
- Suitable environment Pupils must be physically located in safe working spaces, appropriate for online lessons; a lounge or study is appropriate, a bedroom or bathroom is not.
- For the safety and wellbeing of pupils, parents should ensure the video feature of Zoom is not enabled.

Coming Weeks

We will inshaAllah proceed with online lessons as follows:

Monday 14th **September** – Introductory session (teacher/student /parents introductions and get used to online platform)

Tuesday 15th September– Online lessons start (for at least two weeks)

We will continue to monitor and review our processes and set-up during the coming days and weeks. Madrasah arrangements, therefore will remain subject to change. At the same time we will continue to plan for a phased on-site re-opening and will communicate arrangements to parents accordingly.
