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Summary of Safety Measures for re-opening the Jamia (Alimiyyah Only) following Covid-19 Lockdown on 07 June 2021

- 1. Full risk assessment written. RE: safety measures:
 - Sudents/Parents informed via meetings in October 2020 and provided written guidance + updates.
 - Staff informed during INSET day 22 October 2020 & 04 June 2021
 - Pupils informed on 22 October 2020 and 07 June 2021 (Alimiyyah) and 1st day back, (Maktab)
- 2. What to do if
 - you have symptoms,
 - someone in your house has symptoms
 - you or someone in your house has tested positive

Explained to staff, parents and pupils

- 3. Social distancing and hand washing/sanitising postersdisplayed throughout the Jamia
- 4. **PPE Equipment** bought and stored
- 5. Staff room adjustments made for social distancing
- 6. **Hand sanitisers installed** outside every classroom
- 7. Pupils taught how to wash hands
- 8. Pupils taught how to safely wear, take off and dispose facecoverings
- 9. Jamia **cleaning schedule** revised
- 10. Waiting area for visitors removed. Visitors to be let in at time of appointment only.
- 11. **Behaviour policy updated** with clear sanctions in place for anyone ignoring or deliberately flouting the rules, including exclusion where required.
- 12. The classes will be split into **2** Bubbles. Each Bubble has **own entry/exit** point, **own WCs, own classrooms/areas**. No physical inter-bubble interaction inside the Jamia premises
- 13. **Teachers move to each class** according to the timetable. **Lessons and subjects amended** to minimise teacher movements in Jamia.
- 14. Minimise cross contamination between Jamia and home:
 - No one to keep personal stationary in Jamia
 - Little or no written work to be physically brought in.
 - Personal digital devices to be used.
- 15. Activities that involve shared resources/equipment are avoided or cleaned prior to use each time
- 16. Pupils cannot share equipment etc.
- 17. In Jamia marking: self marking policy provided to teachers
- 18. Staggered leaving times N/A;

- 19. If multiple classes need to use a specialist room on same day, then cleaning procedure will identified between class usage (e.g. for IT lab, pupils given wipes to clean keyboard, mouse, table prior to use)
- 20. Library closed
- 21. Guidance will be issued how and where to access **class resources online** for all pupils (especially useful for those who have to self-isolate)
- 22. **Pupils cannot visit** the main office or other staff areas
- 23. All pupil tables/chairs are forward facing(face whiteboard)
- 24. All teachers and students to wear face coverings in communal areas.
- 25. **Car sharing protocols**/travelling protocols for mixed bubble co-travellers
- 26. Parents must avoid congregating at the Jamia entrance.
- 27. Pupils to disperse away from Jamia ASAP.
- 28. Audit staff and pupils to assess the clinically vulnerability & extremely clinically vulnerable (and close family members). Individual risk assessments written as necessary.
- 29. Fire procedures reviewed and revised
- 30. No non-essential visitors are admitted to Jamia
- 31. A staff rota for additional Fire Marshalls will be drawn up to cover any absences.
- 32. **Wellbeing/mental health** issues are discussed with pupils
- 33. **Deliveries** are managed effectively in a timely manner, with recipients adhering to social distancing and wearing PPE where appropriate.
- 34. Staff and pupils are regularly reminded about social distancing and sanitising.
